While there are many things that people may understand about why they celebrate or not celebrate December 25 (the birth of Jesus), the fact lies on the truth about what the event is about on that day whichever day that was circa 2000 years ago. The spiritual importance of this event goes beyond any type of manmade traditional birthday party, physical worship, Babylonian myths and Constantine's or Roman Vatican style political agenda.

The birth of Jesus is the most amazing and remarkable event in the history of God's dealings with mankind. When we look up scripture regarding this event, the Gospel according to John gives us an insight on what we should meditate upon and thank God every day of our lives, and to keep in our hearts as the greatest treasure we could have ever received. **"The Word became flesh."**

What many do on the 25th of December has very little to do with the event in itself and what it should be about. Many celebrate but do not understand about the incarnation. In fact it is this very truth that most people in the world have rejected, refusing to believe that Jesus is the son of God and also God and that He took on human flesh at His first coming that He gave His life, shed His blood, then resurrected from the dead, and ascended into Heaven, which was the only way mankind could be reconciled to God and have the blessed hope of an eternal life in His presence. But the majority of the world celebrates as an occasion to have fun and frolic, with very little or no spiritual meaning for them.

(John chapter 1) *In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things were made through Him, and without Him nothing was made that was made. ⁴ In Him was life, and the life was the light of men. ⁵ And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.*

Jesus is "the Word" later in verse 14 we see that "The Word became flesh" which is the birth of Jesus; in the book of Revelation Jesus is also called "The Word of God" when He will be returning with the armies of heaven to judge the nations and physically rule on this earth.

(Rev. 19:11–16). *Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called **Faithful and True**, and in righteousness **He judges and makes war**. ¹² His eyes were like a **flame of fire**, and on His head were **many crowns**. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. ¹³ He was clothed with a **robe dipped in blood**, and His name is called **The Word of God**. ¹⁴ And the **armies in heaven**, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, **followed Him on white horses**. ¹⁵ Now out of His mouth goes a **sharp sword**, that with it He should **strike the nations**. And **He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron**. He Himself treads the winepress of the **fierceness and wrath of Almighty God**. ¹⁶ And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: **KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS**.*

(This is the same birthday baby Jesus that the world celebrates which many do not know, and should be told about)

Here is the vision of the Second Coming of our Lord Jesus Christ; this is a very important revelation of God to us through the scriptures. In the Old and New Testament there are thousands of verses that point towards the second coming of Jesus Christ, after the subject of faith (repentance and turning back to God), there is no other subject mentioned more than the return of Jesus. During some research, I came across these statistics from an article published in; (Today in the Word)

(Biblical prophecy provides some of the greatest encouragement and hope available to us today. Just as the Old Testament is saturated with prophecies concerning Christ's first advent, so both testaments are filled with references to the Second Coming of Christ. One scholar has estimated that there are 1,845 references

to Christ's Second Coming in the Old Testament, where 17 books give it prominence. In the 260 chapters of the New Testament, there are 318 references to the second advent of Christ—an amazing 1 out of every 30 verses. Twenty-three of the 27 New Testament books refer to this great event. For every prophecy in the Bible concerning Christ's first advent, there are 8 which look forward to His second!")

1 Peter 1: 3–5 tells us that God has given us a living hope through His mercy; ³ *Blessed be the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who according to His abundant mercy has begotten us again to a living hope through the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,* ⁴ *to an inheritance incorruptible and undefiled and that does not fade away, reserved in heaven for you,* ⁵ *who are kept by the power of God through faith for salvation ready to be revealed in the last time.*

(That surely is also something we should celebrate everyday)

In the book of Romans this hope is not something we can see (Rom. 8:24–25) *For we were saved in this hope, but hope that is seen is not hope; for why does one still hope for what he sees? ²⁵But if we hope for what we do not see, we eagerly wait for it with perseverance.*

And in 1 Peter 3: 15 *But sanctify the Lord God in your hearts, and always be ready to give a defense to everyone who asks you a reason for the hope that is in you, with meekness and fear;*

The hope of every true Christian is in the future for there will be a time when he will be completely Holy, and all rebelliousness comes to an end, he will be transformed, body and soul to an incorruptible and immortal being living eternally in the presence of his creator, with no more struggles but peace and rest; Rev21:4 *And God will wipe away every tear from their eyes; there shall be no more death, nor sorrow, nor crying. There shall be no more pain, for the former things have passed away."*

The way to this hope is through humility and surrender to God, It does not come from religions or wisdom and traditions of men, but from the immense love and mercy of our creator God that in the fullness of time sent His son *Jesus into the world, that we might live through Him. In this is love, not that we loved God, but that He loved us and sent His Son to be the propitiation for our sins.* (1John 4:9–10)

Galatians 4: 1–11 *Now I say that the heir, as long as he is a child, does not differ at all from a slave, though he is master of all, ² but is under guardians and stewards until the time appointed by the father. ³ Even so we, when we were children, were in bondage under the elements of the world. ⁴ But when the fullness of the time had come, God sent forth His Son, born of a woman, born under the law, ⁵ to redeem those who were under the law, that we might receive the adoption as sons. ⁶ And because you are sons, God has sent forth the Spirit of His Son into your hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" ⁷ Therefore you are no longer a slave but a son, and if a son, then an heir of God through Christ. ⁸ But then, indeed, when you did not know God, you served those which by nature are not gods. ⁹ But now after you have known God, or rather are known by God, how is it that you turn again to the weak and beggarly elements, to which you desire again to be in bondage? ¹⁰ You observe days and months and seasons and years. ¹¹ I am afraid for you, lest I have labored for you in vain.*

The Lord Jesus Christ is our hope; *His name is called the Word of God. All things were made by Him and without Him was not anything made that was made.* The Word of God is Christ Jesus, the incarnate One who is also the Creator. He is the One Who Was and Is and Is to come.

John 1:14 And *the Word became flesh and dwelt among us, and we beheld His glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father, full of grace and truth.*

We also see In John 1:4–5 that the *Word was life and that this life was the light of men. And the light shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.*

The life is the Living word Jesus, the light is the fullness of spiritual life. All that belongs to God is light and darkness is all that opposes Him. God is light, and in Him there is no darkness at all. The light of the gospel which brings true spiritual life is through Jesus Christ which is shining to all of mankind that is in the darkness, whether in false religions, traditions of men and philosophies, but darkness cannot comprehend this light and so they resist it.

As Paul states in 2 Cor. 4:4, *the god of this world has blinded the minds of the unbelieving, that they might not see the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God.*

God sent the Living Word to fulfill, clarify, explain, and demonstrate the written Word so we can be completely without excuse, when the Word became flesh He did not just teach spiritual truth, but gave us a practical example to follow: and those that believe in Him and follow, have the living word written in their hearts.

(2 Cor. 3:3). *“Clearly you are an epistle of Christ, ministered by us, written not with ink but by the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of flesh, that is, of the heart”*

We witness, participate and celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ every day by simply obeying His word in our daily living. The Word becomes flesh, not when the world has decided to celebrate the birth of Jesus, but from the time that a person realizes that he is a sinner at the sight of our Holy God, repents and asks for forgiveness and accepts that the forgiveness received can only come through the shed blood of the son of God Jesus Christ, who is equal to God and took on the nature of Man and died at Calvary and was raised on the third day and is alive today, then not only listens or agrees with His teachings, but abides in them.

Here is the promise: *“He who has My commandments and keeps them, it is he who loves Me. And he who loves Me will be loved by My Father, and I will love him and manifest Myself to him”* (John 14:21).

The only way the birth of our Lord Jesus will ever have any meaning for mankind, is to have a relationship with God, this comes through repentance and believing in Him and the finished work at Calvary, then to continue to pursue holiness through the help of the Holy Spirit by being steadfast in His word. We are then celebrating His birth every day as we worship Him by being obedient to His commandments and pursue holiness as we wait for His return; any other type of celebration is just man’s vanity!

The message that we are to share to the world is the gospel that has the power to save, that Jesus being equal to God incarnated as a man to bring salvation and that The Word that was made flesh Jesus our Rock and savior will be coming again soon to Judge the world as KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.

Titus 2:11–14 our great God and Savior Jesus Christ

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men, ¹² teaching us that, denying ungodliness and worldly lusts, we should live soberly, righteously, and godly in the present age, ¹³ looking for the blessed hope and glorious appearing of our great God and Savior Jesus Christ, ¹⁴ who gave Himself for us, that He might redeem us from every lawless deed and purify for Himself His own special people, zealous for good works.

Even so, come Lord Jesus!

Psalm 111

Praise the Lord!

I will praise the Lord with my whole heart,

In the assembly of the upright and in the congregation.

2 The works of the Lord are great, Studied by all who have pleasure in them.

3 His work is honorable and glorious, And His righteousness endures forever.

5 He has given food to those who fear Him; He will ever be mindful of His covenant.

Proverbs 3:13-18

Blessed is the one who finds wisdom, and the one who gets understanding,

14 for the gain from her is better than gain from silver and her profit better than gold.

15 She is more precious than jewels, and nothing you desire can compare with her.

16 Long life is in her right hand; in her left hand are riches and honor.

17 Her ways are ways of pleasantness, and all her paths are peace.

18 She is a tree of life to those who lay hold of her; those who hold her fast are called blessed.

James 1:5–8 *If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. 6 But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. 7 For let not that man suppose that he will receive anything from the Lord; 8 he is a double-minded man, unstable in all his ways.*

Spiritual wisdom is God's wisdom (righteousness) which is the revelation of God's Will through His Word (knowledge) then applying this to our daily living. (Contrasting with worldly wisdom)

From the very beginning the plan of God to redeem us has destroyed the wisdom of the worldly wise men because human wisdom can never comprehend God's plan for salvation;

(1Co 1:19–20) For it is written: *"I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, And bring to nothing the understanding of the prudent."* ²⁰ *Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this age? Has not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?*

Every true believer that has a desire and searches for the wisdom of God, a battle will start with human wisdom which is limited, but throughout scriptures we see that the people who followed God were in contrast with the wisdom of the world, and submitted to the Holy Spirit to teach the wisdom from God which is needed to understand the spiritual;

(1Cor 2:12–13) *Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us by God. ¹³These things we also speak, not in words which man's wisdom teaches but which the Holy Spirit teaches, comparing spiritual things with spiritual.*

Human wisdom is foolishness to God (1Co 3:18–21).

Let no one deceive himself. If anyone among you seems to be wise in this age, let him become a fool that he may become wise. ¹⁹For the wisdom of this world is foolishness with God. For it is written, "He catches the wise in their own craftiness"; (Job 5:13) ²⁰ and again, "The Lord knows the thoughts of the wise, that they are futile." (Psalm 94:11) ²¹ Therefore let no one boast in men.

The first step to obtaining spiritual wisdom is the fear of God and to be conscious of our need for it. All people will search for wisdom, but there is only one type of wisdom that brings glory and honour to God and us to salvation, that wisdom comes from God Himself.

Proverbs 9:10 says, *"The fear of the LORD is the beginning of wisdom, and knowledge of the Holy One is understanding."*

The wisdom that comes from God is foundational to our spiritual growth; all other types of learning are worthless unless they are built upon the knowledge of the Lord Himself. Those who fear the Lord have a continual awareness of Him, a deep reverence for Him, and commitment to obey Him.

Wisdom in Hebrew is (Chokmah) in the OT and in Greek NT it is (sophia) knowledge is (daath) in the Hebrew OT and (gnosis) Greek in the NT. ⁶

They are distinctly two different words but inseparable in regards to spiritual life. If one has the knowledge of God without the Wisdom of God, is just mental understanding which can be easily be manipulated by human wisdom and put into use according to one's own interpretation .

The right use of knowledge can only be implemented by receiving the Wisdom of God; the first principle to receive biblical wisdom is that we should humble ourselves before a Holy God in reverence and worship, obedient to His word. Godly Wisdom enables us to apply the Knowledge of God in a correct way to reach Gods purpose in the end view. It is practical spiritual truth without theories and ideas that have been established by God of which the right application enables us to meet His conditions in order that His perfect will and purpose can be fulfilled in us according to His will.

Pray for God's Wisdom

If any of you lacks wisdom, let him ask of God, who gives to all liberally and without reproach, and it will be given to him. ⁶ But let him ask in faith, with no doubting, for he who doubts is like a wave of the sea driven and tossed by the wind. (James 1:5-6)

The motivation that leads us to pray and ask for His Wisdom and to live a life according to the will of God comes from faith – loving the LORD our God with all our heart and with all our soul and with all our mind and strength. It comes from a deep pure love for our God who loved us first, because of what He has done for us as the apostle Paul tells us in Romans chapter 5 verses 8; “*God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us*”.

This He did in the past for us; ***He sent His Son Jesus who died for us***; in the next verses we also see that because of this, now and in the continuing present mankind can be reconciled to Him (through repentance and believing in His son Jesus) “***having now been justified by His blood***” and not only this but also the future promise that; “***we shall be saved from wrath that is to come through Him***”. And; “***we shall be saved by His life***”.

Romans 5: 8-11; “*God demonstrates His own love toward us, in that while we were still sinners, Christ died for us. ⁹Much more then, having now been justified by His blood, we shall be saved from wrath through Him. ¹⁰ For if when we were enemies we were reconciled to God through the death of His Son, much more, having been reconciled, we shall be saved by His life. ¹¹ And not only that, but we also rejoice in God through our Lord Jesus Christ, through whom we have now received the reconciliation*”.

Bearing this in mind the life of a Christian now belongs to God who has purchased us through the shed blood of Jesus Christ, we should be joyful, rejoicing, and prayerful in thanksgiving everyday and in every circumstance.

We can only show our Love in response to His Love for us through our actions and those actions need to be directed according to God's will, by receiving His wisdom through the Holy Spirit and to act upon His word, we cannot do this unless we have a personal intimate relationship with Him, by talking to Him through prayer and listening to Him.

This is so important for us in these days when the schemes of the enemy of God and His followers are becoming more apparent as prophesies are being fulfilled, we can see Apostasy and a falling away from true doctrine just as the apostle Paul reminds Timothy; (2 Timothy chapter 3)

But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: ² For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, ³ unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, ⁴ traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, ⁵ having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!

Then in chapter 4 continues to urge and commands Timothy to stand firm and be ready and be watchful and exhort, correct and instruct at all times. *I charge you therefore before God and the Lord Jesus Christ, who will judge the living and the dead at His appearing and His kingdom: ² Preach the word! Be ready in season and out of season. Convince, rebuke, exhort, with all longsuffering and teaching. ³ For the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine, but according to their own desires, because they have itching ears, they will heap up for themselves teachers;⁴ and they will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables. ⁵ But you be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfil your ministry.*

And also in many other passages we are warned of false prophets in 2 Peter 2:1 *who will secretly bring in destructive heresies, even denying the Lord who bought them, and bring on themselves swift destruction. ² And many will follow their destructive ways, because of whom the way of truth will be blasphemed. ³ By covetousness they will exploit you with deceptive words.*

We thank and praise the Lord for His revelation through His word and that we can ask and pray for His wisdom to comprehend His word and to put it into practice, as we see these and other prophecies being unfolded in front of our eyes, we need to be prepared and ready in His might and power to stand firm and not be swayed left or right according to the schemes of the enemy.

There are congregations of believers today that are striving to stand firm in God's truth and are not compromising the word of God with worldly philosophies of men mixed with some biblical truths. But because of this standing firm, many have been and are being ridiculed and named either as fundamentalists or radicals or cults directly and indirectly. But that comes to no surprise we have been told that those that have put their trust and faith in our Lord Jesus by following Him as he has commanded and are proclaiming the truth of His word, will be hated by the world, the enemy will try to weary down and disrupt that truth, craftily pointing us upon a broader and easier worldly path, which eventually leads to a falling away and destruction.

Knowing that these things will happen we strive to stand firm to the word of God, by edifying and exhorting one and other from falling into the schemes and traps of the evil one.

The schemes that are being used by the enemy at times are not so evident and may not seem harmful, but in reality (truth of the Bible) they are lies that are told with such flattery and human logic by which many vulnerable God seekers are being deceived, (traditions and philosophies of men, interfaith unity (ecumenism), and the claim it and receive it gospel of prosperity and wealth hedonism and Humanism) are all being used as a means to lead many towards personal desires, personal gain personal pleasure and purpose instead of submitting to God and pursuing His purpose and His will.

Many churches and religious organizations today will use traditions, philosophy and twisted scripture to justify the worldly actions of ungodly people that are being introduced into the church by "Christianizing" what is profane (unholy) and then calling it Holy and acceptable to God.

The problem with this is that man cannot make the rules or move the goalposts to suit his way of thinking, our LORD God has already established and revealed what is Holy and what is not.

Our LORD God does not need our help by promoting a new way to worship Him using man made traditions and philosophies to glorify His name, by doing this we are assuming that His ways are not sufficient and complete or that He would have to adjust according to the times, whereas the truth is that it is man that needs to adjust to His ways.

Many today are setting aside biblical sound doctrine for the love of unity and world peace (tolerance and Humanism) but this is not what the bible tells us to do, for any tolerance to what is profane (unholy) is siding with the enemy of God.

The churches that in this age are holding fast to the biblical foundations of doctrines in regards to worship and Christian living that are not following the mainstream Christian view are becoming more and more unpopular and fewer, whereas in contrast the majority that are going with the flow and desires of man are a more acceptable way to the world, which will also bring an increase of worldly and ungodly members in the church and their ways. In other words just as in any other type of worldly business the customer is always right (if you want repeated business) but we cannot treat the word of God and His people in this same manner.

The word of God and His ways are Just and those who desire to belong to Him are sinners and need to submit to Him to receive forgiveness and instruction, submission means obedience to His word.

Many may say that when we become His children we receive His power, that is correct we do, His power is in His truth but we have no authority to change that truth and mix it with anything else, it remains His truth as He has revealed it, as it has been, as it is and as it will forever be, immutable and unchanging.

God is truth, God's word is truth, Jesus the son of God is the Word of God born in the flesh and the light that gives life to what was dead, when the light of truth shines in the darkness it brings to surface what is truly in the heart of man, and that causes a reaction either to rebel against it or to repent and submit to God and His word through Jesus.

But the proud will not humble in submission to the truth, pride causes people to go their own way instead of God's way, *"God resists the proud, but gives grace to the humble."*

The world will force the remnant people of God, those who truly desire to follow Him, to the ways of the world and will make it difficult to follow God in truth and Spirit, the easy way is to compromise (broad way), standing firm is resistance to this (narrow way) and is spiritual warfare.

Satan does not mind when people gather to sing and preach how to achieve personal success, wealth and prosperity or when planning world peace by setting aside truth, those people are no threat to his plans of darkness. But when the people of God preach and teach the gospel that convicts sinners of their sin in the presence of a Holy God, and points them to Repentance to God and forgiveness of sin through the blood of Jesus the messiah the son of God, "Satan starts to notice".

When a church calls and encourages one and other to obedience, to pursue Holiness in this world full of evil, to worship Him in truth and in Spirit to stay away from idolatry, to not worship Him as the nations worship their gods; just as thousands of years ago when God warned the children of Israel "Satan starts to notice".

But do not fear: *"You are of God, little children, and have overcome them, because He who is in you is greater than he who is in the world"*. (1 John 4:4)

We pray that the Lord will show us His mercy and forgiveness and fill all His children (the universal church of Jesus Christ) afresh with His Holy Spirit in order that the wisdom of God may dominate within His church , so that we may serve, worship and live our lives according to His purpose and will, that He protects and helps us to persevere in the faith that we have received regardless of our circumstances, that He gives us His strength and boldness to proclaim the truth of the Gospel that has the power to save to a world that is in darkness, and that we may be found in Him when He returns, in the name of Jesus Christ (Yeshua Ha-Mashiach) the son of the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob , Immanuel (God is with us), The Word that was made flesh, the Faithful and True, the Lion of Judah , THE KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS, Amen.
